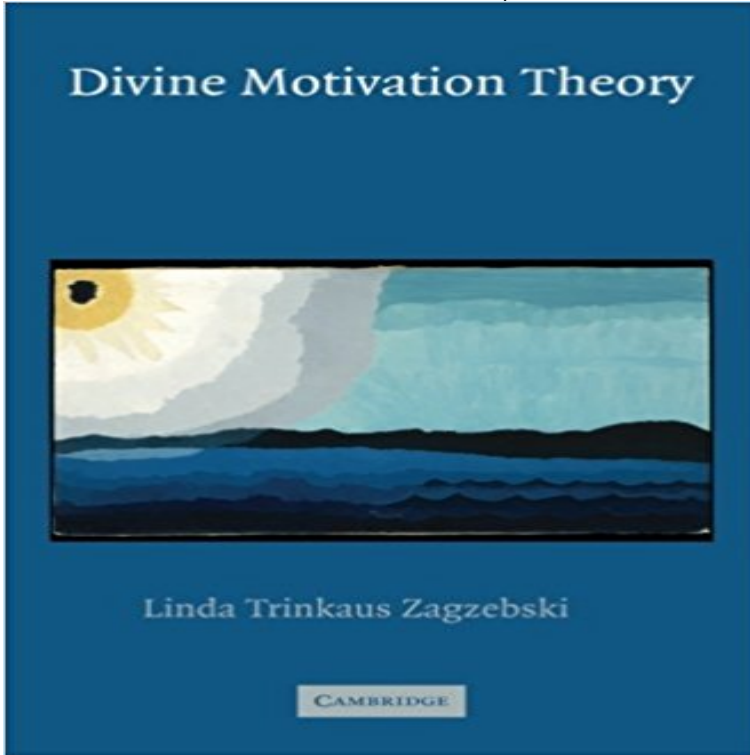


Divine Motivation Theory
