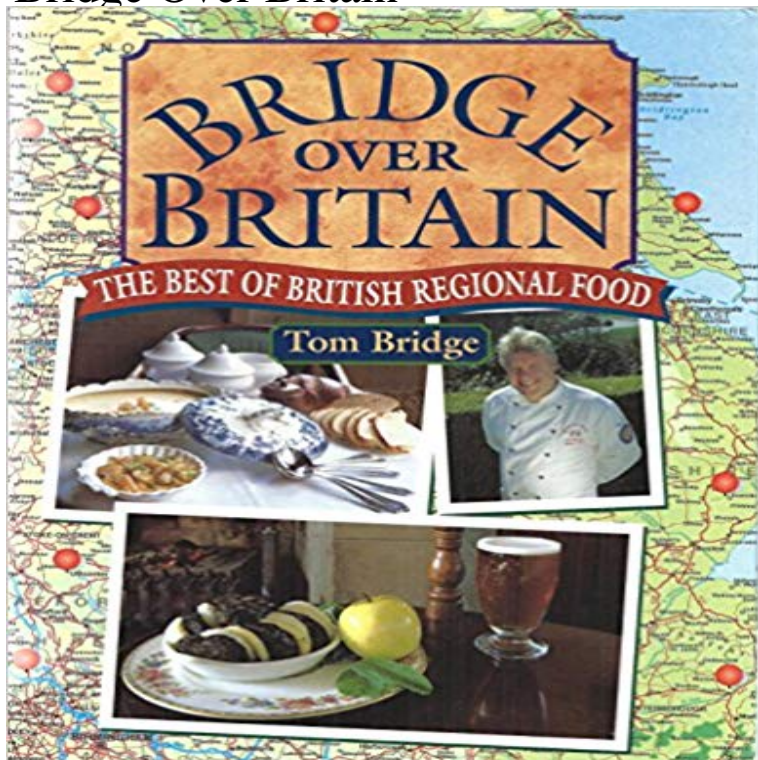


Bridge Over Britain
